Osei shall be posthumously conferred the prestigious Mother Icon of Peace (**MiP Award**) by the Association of the Ambassadors for Peace of Ghana. This highest honor is in solemn recognition of her outstanding accomplishments, maternal leadership, and lifelong dedication to building national unity and global peace.
